The DEC Water Supply Division is holding a public meeting. This meeting is a brainstorming session to gather input for two purposes:

- 1) How the Water Supply Division should regulate new water line extensions which is a follow-up to the meeting held on January 18, 2007 and
- 2) How the Water Supply Division should regulate existing consecutive water systems. Agency of Natural Resources Secretary George Crombie has asked the Division to study the regulation of existing consecutive water systems and make recommendations to him by the end of September 2007.

Following the meeting, two workgroups will be formed to make recommendations to the Division and ANR Secretary. The Division held two meetings in June 2007 with representatives from a number of the larger public water systems to receive input regarding this process and develop a framework for this public meeting.
